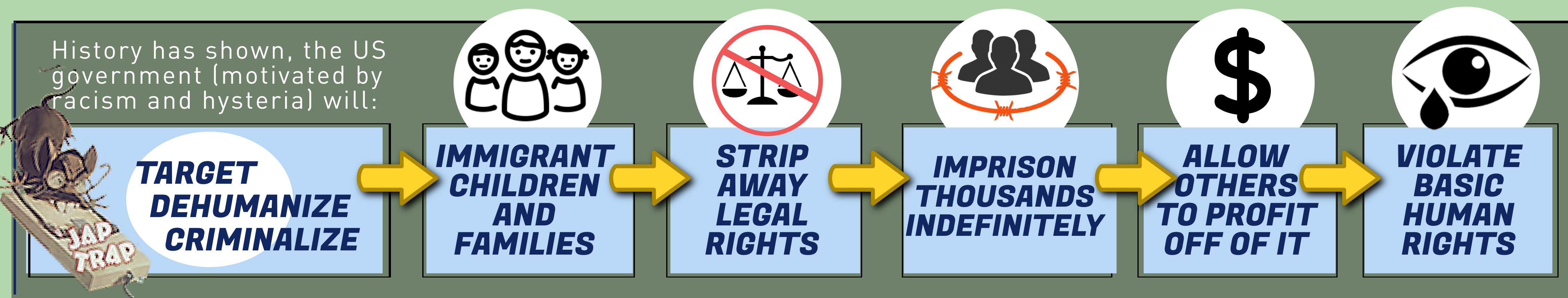

INCALCULABLE LOSS

The forced removal of Japanese Americans and immigrants to camps across the country - resulted in the loss of freedom, rights, property, dignity and the erosion of our language and culture. Some even lost their lives due to stress, harsh living conditions, lack of medical care, or were shot by guards.



CULTURE OF SILENCE

The anger, shame, and trauma of mass incarceration made it difficult for our elders to talk about Camp. Now is the time to talk about our experience and raise our collective voices!



SPEAKING OUT

Together with Immigrant Rights groups, Native Americans, and other allies -former JA Internees and descendants travel to Fort Sill to say, "NEVER AGAIN!"

FORT SILL, OKLAHOMA CHILD DETENTION CAMP

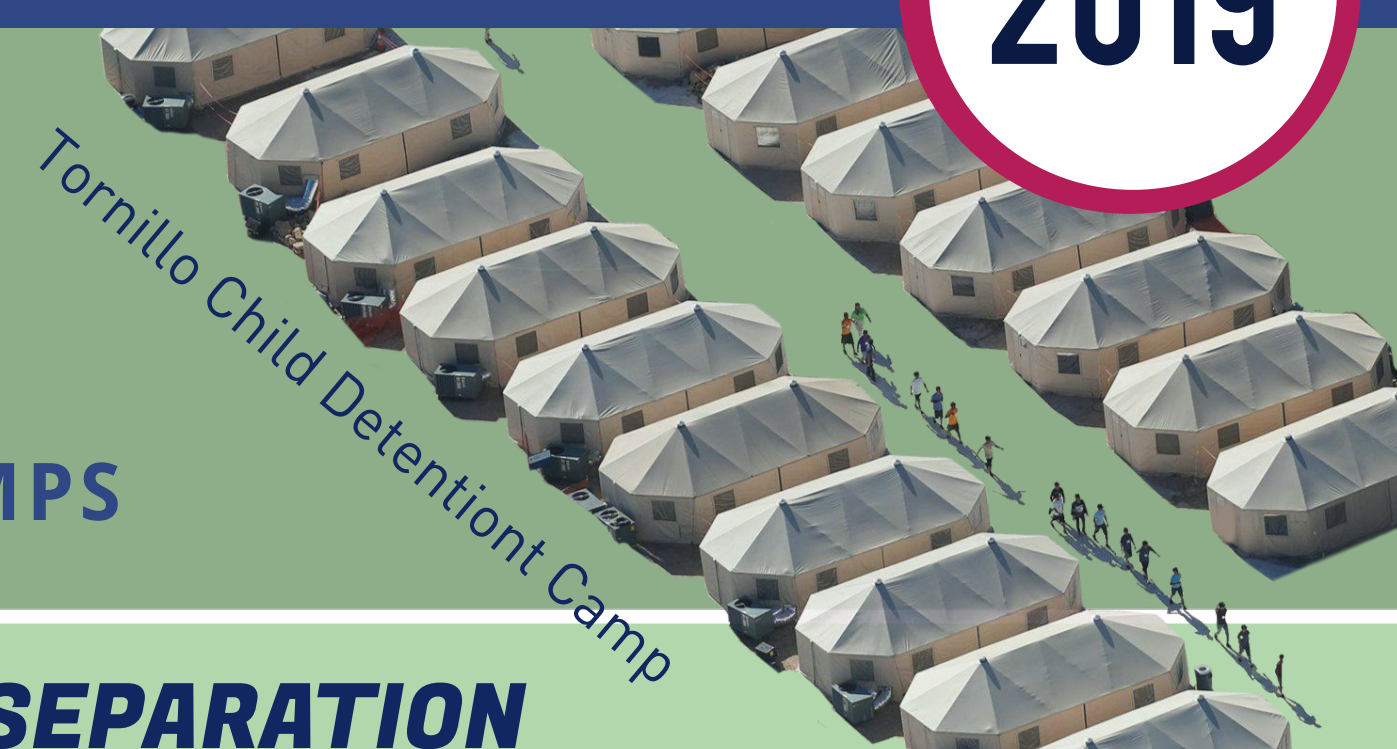
The U.S. Government interned 700 JAs during WWII and 400 Native Americans in 1894 at Fort Sill. Now Trump wants to house 1,400 migrant children there.

FAMILY SEPARATION

Trump's Family Separation policy resulted in over 2,000 children being illegally and ruthlessly separated from their families - causing irreparable harm and trauma.

KIDS IN CAGES

Children are being subjected to systematic abuse, deplorable conditions and a lack of basic necessities, and medical care.

CHILDREN DYING IN CAMPS

7 children have died in less than a year in US custody (when there hasn't been a death in over 10 years) - due to Trump's inhumane immigration policies.
